## TOOTSIE CAMPAIGN FOR DEVELOPMENTLY HANDICAPPED A SUCCESS

Many thanks to all of you who worked on the Tootsie Roll Campaign this year, you did a fine job. We did better than ever this year, so your efforts were certainly worthwhile. This is what we collected- 784 pennies, 284 nickels, 455 dimes, 921 quarters, 1081 one dollar bills, 1 two dollar, 58 fives, 9 tens, 6 twenties, and 4 checks totally \$45.00.

The grand total was \$1,925.77 - a record collection!

Many have asked where this money goes. We send it to the State Council and they send it where we direct them. It must be given to certain approved charities who work with the mentally disadvantaged. We have been directing our collected funds to ARC of Southeastern Minnesota, which is Rochester based and has programs for the mentally retarded in the Rochester area (for instance, they do the Halloween party that in the past we held at the KC Hall) and also Rochester Special Religious Ed, which conducts religious education for the mentally retarded.

Those of us who collected can attest that the people of Rochester appreciate what we are doing and are happy to contribute. They recognize our uniform, Tootsie Rolls and K of C apron, and gladly dig up a contribution.

A special thanks to Ed Fujan who does the calling, and helps collect at church. His enthusiasm is infectious!
